- Contact the Lead Carpenter and/or Site Superintendent to initiate change orders and obtain cost approval prior to starting work on any additional scope



- Document labor hours and description of work at the end of each day to ensure accuracy in labor billing
- Support project Quality Control
- Maintain a clean, organized Job Site
- If applicable, replenish truck supplies each week with all required consumable materials to avoid avoidable trips to supply yards during normal job hours
- If applicable, perform standard maintenance to your assigned vehicle such as oil and coolant levels, etc., check for burned out bulbs and replace as needed, and report major problems requiring professional repair
- Uphold professional client/employee/vendor relationships with a strong commitment to client service

- Able to read floor plans and elevation details
- Keen accuracy for details including measurements
